Adopt-A-Hydrant Program

- 1. Maintain a (3') three-foot radius around the hydrant free of clear of snow and shrubbery
- 2. Keep an eye out for signs of vandalism or removal of caps.
- 3. The hydrant is painted in the following way
 - a. Body painted red
 - b. Top painted blue
 - c. Caps painted white

Paint will be provided by South Bend Water Works. Call 235-9464

- 4. Winter flags are put in place by the South Bend Water Works. Let the Water Works know prior to November if you would like a flag. There is a limited number and they are placed on hydrants that tend to get buried in the snow.
- 5. Call Clay Fire Territory if you notice the hydrant is leaking or has been damaged.
- 6. Individuals and/or groups are encouraged to participate.
- 7. A certificate will be issued to you and/or your group upon adopting a hydrant.
